DEB HAALAND Secretary of the Interior As the first Native American in this position, she will oversee federally-owned natural resources, including national parks.



- Jan. 27th- Executive Order-<u>Committee On revitalizing energy</u> <u>communities</u>
- March 29th- Memo, <u>Jumpstarting</u> <u>Offshore wind projects</u>
- March 31st- Proposed Bill for the <u>American Jobs Plan</u>
 - Civilian Climate Corps
 - Plugging Oil wells and mines
 - Renewing Production Tax Credit
 - ½ million EV charging stations by 2030, 20% of U.S. school buses electric
 - Carbon capture investment

- Jan. 20th Executive Order <u>Rejoining the Paris Climate</u> <u>Agreement</u>
- Jan. 20th Executive Order <u>Pausing new oil and natural gas</u> <u>leases on public lands</u> and end fossil fuel subsidies from Federal Agencies
- Jan. 27th Executive Order- <u>Keystone XL Pipeline permit</u> <u>revoked</u>
- Jan. 27th Executive Order- <u>White House Environmental</u> Justice Interagency Council
- Jan. 27th Executive Order- <u>Commits to conserving at least</u> <u>30% of lands and oceans by 2030</u>
- March 31st Proposed Bill for the American Jobs Plan
 - Energy Efficiency and Clean Standard
